Gallinipper



This is one of the largest mosquitoes in Kansas. The larvae of this common species feed on other small aquatic insects, including mosquito larvae. Adults, which are severe biters, are common from March to November.

Treehole Mosquito



This is the common black species that breeds in tree holes and other standing water.

Vexans Mosquito



This mosquito propagates in dirty water or floodwater and is a pest from early spring to late fall.
